



TRAVEL INFO

Check-in begins Monday, July 11, at 7:00am. (Westlink/Valley Center meet at the Westlink Campus; Goddard meets at Goddard Campus.) Our schedule should bring us into Lincoln, NE around 12:30pm. **Lunch will not be provided, your student will need to pack one for the trip.** We leave MOVE Friday, July 15 and arrive at the same campus as drop off around 10:30pm.

WHAT TO BRING

- Bible, notebook, and pen or pencil
- Modest clothing for 5 days; Each student is limited to 1 suitcase & 1 backpack.
- Athletic clothing for recreation time (tennis shoes strongly recommended due to several miles walked each day)
- Athletic equipment for recreation time. (basketball, tennis, soccer ball, frisbee, etc.)
- Bedding to fit a single bed (or sleeping bag), pillow
- Personal toiletry items, washcloth, towel, soap, and deodorant
- Sunscreen and a water bottle to refill
- Prescription medicine; Students are responsible for their own medications.
- Money for lunch downtown Lincoln Thursday, extra activities, campus store, CIY store, etc.
- Towel and swimsuit (only one-piece suits or tankini suits that overlaps, no speedos for boys)
- Snack food—no peanut products!

CAMPUS RULES

- Be where you're supposed to be and be on time.
- Travel in groups of two or more around campus at all times.
- Small groups can go off campus during free time only with a leader.
- Lost keys and swipe cards are \$35 each to be paid by student.
- Obey campus boundaries as explained upon arrival at University of Nebraska
- No one in dorms or room areas of opposite gender. **ZERO TOLERANCE.**
- No threats, fighting, or violence.
- No drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or weapons.
- No skateboards, scooters, etc.
- Don't bring expensive items (electronics, jewelry, etc.)

COVID SAFETY

This summer we are taking extra steps to ensure the safety of our students and volunteers in regards to COVID-19. Students will not need to wear a mask on the bus, in their dorm rooms and suite, or outdoors. Temperature checks will be checked before students get on the bus on departure day. We have worked with MOVE and UNL to limit exposure between small groups through scheduling and activities. COVID-19 tests are available at camp if a student or leader shows symptoms.

In the case of a positive COVID-19 test: Positive students and leaders will be isolated and cared for until we can arrange transport home. Refunds would be figured and processed upon return.
