



TRAVEL INFO

This year for MIX, we will travel to New Life Ranch—Frontier Cove in Adair, OK using Village Charter Buses. Check-in begins Tuesday, June1, at 9:00am. (Westlink/Valley Center meet at the Westlink Campus; Goddard meets at Goddard Campus.) Our schedule should bring us into New Life Ranch around 2:30pm. Lunch WILL NOT be provided, your student will need to pack one for the trip. We LEAVE MIX Saturday, June 5 at 8:00am and ARRIVE at the same campus as drop off around 12:30pm.

THINGS TO BRING

- Bible, notebook, and pen or pencil
- Modest clothing for 5 days; shoes, socks, jacket, etc.
- Athletic clothing for recreation time (tennis shoes strongly recommended)
- Bedding to fit a single bed (or sleeping bag), pillow
- Closed toe shoes and pants (needed for some extra activities)
- Flashlight, personal toiletry items, washcloth, towel, and soap
- Medicine (must be checked in with Medication Card upon arrival at Pathway)
- Money for mission offering, snacks, and gift shop
- Towel and swimsuit (only one-piece suits or tankini suits that overlaps)
- Bug spray and sunscreen
- Snack food—no peanut products!

RULES & DRESS

- Comply without argument with all staff.
- Be on time for all activities.
- Respect the property of others.
- Dress modestly. Watch the length of shorts and skirts. No Spaghetti straps shirts.
- Swimwear—No bikinis or 2-piece swimsuits (only one-piece suits or tankini suits that overlaps)
- Stay in appropriate cabins (Do not go in any cabin but your own)
- No threats or fighting.
- No drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or weapons of any kind.
- No knives or matches.
- No Electronics
- Cell Phone (not allowed to use; we recommend not bringing)

MEDICATIONS

All over-the-counter and prescription medication must be administered by the Camp Nurse while at MIX. Please complete a Camp Medication Authorization Card. Some over-the-counter medication is provided as needed with parental authorization. If the student needs to take prescription medication, please complete the following steps:

- Step 1: Fill out 2 Medication Authorization Cards, identically.
- Step 2: Put just enough medication for week of camp in its original prescription container.
- Step 3: Put one Medication Authorization Card in container with medication. Leave other card out.
- Step 4: Morning of camp turn in medication container and additional Medication Authorization Card to camp nurse.



BIG SUMMER GIVE

Every summer, the Next Gen ministries across Pathway Church raise money for a good cause called the "Big Summer Give."
