



TRAVEL INFO

Check-in begins Monday, July 10, at 7:00am. All students from all campuses will meet and depart from the Westlink Campus (East Atrium). We should all arrive at camp in Lincoln, NE around 12:30pm. **Lunch will not be provided; your student will need to pack one for the trip.** We leave MOVE Friday, July 14, and arrive at the same campus as drop off around 10:30pm.

WHAT TO BRING

- Bible, notebook, and pen or pencil
- Modest clothing for 5 days; Each student is limited to 1 suitcase & 1 backpack.
- Athletic clothing for recreation time (tennis shoes strongly recommended)
- Athletic equipment for recreation time. (basketball, tennis, soccer ball, frisbee, etc.)
- Bedding to fit a single bed (or sleeping bag), pillow
- Personal toiletry items, washcloth, towel, and soap
- Sunscreen and a water bottle to refill
- Prescription medicine; Students are responsible for their own medications.
- Money for lunch in downtown Tuesday, Thursday excursion, extra activities, campus store, CIY store, etc.
- Towel and swimsuit (only one-piece suits or tankini suits that overlaps, no speedos for boys)
- Snack food—no peanut products!

CAMPUS RULES

- Be where you're supposed to be and be on time.
- Travel in groups of two or more around campus at all times.
- Small groups can go off campus during free time only with a leader.
- Lost keys and swipe cards are \$35 each to be paid by student.

- Don't bring expensive items (electronics, jewelry, etc.)

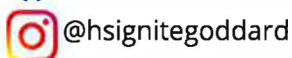
