Westlink Campus:

What to Bring

- Bible, notebook, pen or pencil.

- Bedding to fit a single bed (or sleeping bag) & pillow.
- Towel & wash cloth for showering.
- Sweatshirt or jacket for cooler/wet weather.
- Personal toiletry items (girls are in community bathrooms so plan accordingly.)
- Prescription medicine (inhaler, etc.). Students are responsible for their own medications. If your student is taking a prescription medicine that you didn't record on their Medical Release Form please give this information to the Nurse before departure.
- Breakfast items/snacks for bus ride.
- Money for offering, campus bookstores, Thursday excursion, etc.
- Sunscreen, athletic equipment for rec time (basketball, soccer ball, Frisbee, etc.)
- Water bottle for bus ride and throughout the week.

What NOT to Bring

- Drugs, alcohol, cigarettes.
- Skateboards.
- Silly string, water balloons pranking items– college campus rules.
- Expensive items (electronics, jewelry, etc.). Not responsible for lost or stolen items.
